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Families can connect to their child's Seesaw journal to see student work and celebrate progress. Specifically, they can only see their individual child's work or group projects that their child is tagged in. Connect to a child's journal on the web or by downloading the Seesaw App, available on iOS and Android.

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Students can:

Add posts to their journals. Student posts showcase the creative projects they've been working on in the classroom. This could include photos, artwork, videos, activities, notes, projects they've created in other apps, and more!
